# EUROPEAN VISTAS

## DAY 01: ARRIVE PARIS

Arrival at Paris. Paris, a wonderful city brimming with character, is on every travel lover's bucket list. Known as the "City of Light" or the "City of Love," the streets of Paris overflow with culture, art, beauty, and history. At airport, meet and greet by our representative. Transfer to hotel for check-in. Evening experience **Seine River Cruise** through the heart of Paris, covering major attractions of Paris. Seeing the romantic city of Paris by boat is on the must-do list of most visitors to Paris. These short river cruises allow you to take in many of the highlights of the city. Late evening proceed to Paris hotel for check in. Overnight stay.

## DAY 02: FULL DAY PARIS SIGHTSEEING

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Proceed for a **Full day Guided sightseeing tour of Paris** covering Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, Les Invalides, Pantheon, Place de la Concorde, Palais Garnier. Later we proceed to **Eiffel Tower to climb to its top level 2** to witness a spectacular view of the city. The tower is the tallest structure in France and the most visited paid monument in the world. Afternoon continue the guided sightseeing of Paris. Visit **Louvre Museum**. The Louvre is the world's largest museum and houses one of the most impressive art collections in history. Overnight stay at Paris hotel

## DAY 03: PARIS – BRUSSELS - EINDHOVEN (04 HRS Approx.)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departs Paris to Brussels. On arrival, proceed for a **Guided city tour of the elegant Brussels**, the capital of Belgium and the headquarters of European Union. The sightseeing covers the magnificent grand place with its beautiful gilded buildings. We take you to see the adorable **MannekenPis Statue**, a charming statue of a little boy, today the symbol of Brussels. Here you can taste the famous Belgian chocolates and if you wish you may purchase. We end the tour with a visit to the famous **Atomium**, unavoidable icon of Brussels. This unique piece of architecture, created on the occasion of the World Fair of Brussels in 1958, became the most popular monument of the capital of Europe. Later transfer to Eindhoven Check-in to hotel for overnight stay

## DAY 04: EINDHOVEN - AMSTERDAM - EINDHOVEN (02.5 HS Approx.)

After breakfast, checkout and proceed to Amsterdam, capital city of Netherlands which has gained popularity for its art, rich heritage, amazing canal system and its array of narrow houses, among other things. Enjoy **orientation tour of Amsterdam**. Enjoy **Amsterdam Canal Cruise**. Discover the unique atmosphere of Amsterdam on this 75-minute canal cruise. See the UNESCO world heritage canals, the city's iconic bridges, and waterfront houses. Visit **Madurodam**, a famous miniature park and tourist attraction in The Hague, Netherlands. It features scale models of famous Dutch landmarks, historical cities, and large developments. Evening, check- in to the hotel. Overnight stay in Eindhoven.

## DAY 05: EINDHOVEN - FRANKFURT

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Proceed for **walking sightseeing tour of Cologne**, one of the busiest cities in the world and the fourth-largest in Germany. Explore the old town of Cologne and walk in the footsteps of more than 2000 years moving local history. Experience Dom, Heintelmannchenbrunnen, City Hall, and Fish Market

are just some of the stations, which are presented here by our experienced guide. Afternoon, transfer to Frankfurt. Proceed for a [Guided sightseeing tour of Frankfurt](#) the financial hub of Germany and is on the bank of river Main. The city was almost fully destroyed during 2nd world war and now rebuilt. Later drop at hotel for check in. Overnight stay.

#### DAY 06: FRANKFURT - ZURICH

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Check out and transfer to Breitnau. Set in the serene [Black Forest](#), Breitnau captivates with its stunning natural beauty and tranquil atmosphere. Later, explore the renowned craft of cuckoo clock making and browse for souvenirs. Later, journey towards the majestic [Rhine Falls](#), Europe's largest waterfall, where you'll have free time to marvel at its beauty. Conclude the day with a transfer to Zurich, followed by check-in for an overnight stay at the hotel.

#### DAY 07: ZURICH – LUCERNE – ZURICH

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Begin the morning by visiting the highest mountain in central Switzerland, [Mt. Titlis](#), which is 10,000 ft above sea level. The ascent to Mt. Titlis starts by taking three cable cars; enjoy breath-taking panoramic views of surrounding snow-capped mountains, lakes and picturesque meadows. At Mt. Titlis have free time to play with the snow. After descending from Mt. Titlis transfer to Lucerne. Two hours [walking/shopping tour of Lucerne](#). Lucerne is the most visited tourist destination in Switzerland and is situated on Lake Lucerne. You will visit the Chapel Bridge, the lion monument, The Rues river dam, the Jesuit church etc. Return back to Zurich. Overnight stay.

#### DAY 08: ZURICH - SEEFELD

After breakfast, timely checkout and head to [Innsbruck Orientation City Tour](#). The tour offers a guided exploration of the historic Old Town, showcasing iconic landmarks like the Golden Roof and Hofburg Imperial Palace, providing a comprehensive introduction to the cultural and architectural heritage of this Austrian gem. Later Explore crystal in all its facets at the [Swarovski Crystal Worlds Museum](#) in Wattens. Enter a fantasy world that has fascinated millions of visitors, and discover the magic of the crystal at exhibits and attractions such as the gardens of The Giant, and the “Crystal Cloud” of 800,000 hand-mounted crystals. Transfer to Seefeld for overnight stay.

#### DAY 09: SEEFELD – PADOVA

Today, after breakfast, start your tour from Seefeld with a scenic journey that whisks you through the picturesque Alps, eventually reaching Venice's shimmering canals. Upon arrival, transfer to a [boat](#) that takes you along the iconic waterways of this enchanting city, unveiling breath-taking views of palaces and bridges. Disembark in the heart of Venice and step into a traditional [gondola](#) for a magical ride through narrow, winding canals, capturing the romance and charm of Venice from the water. After a serene gondola ride, savor a leisurely lunch at a canalside café, enjoying Venetian delicacies. As afternoon turns to evening, depart for Padova. Upon arrival in Padova, marvel at the architectural splendour of the [Basilica of Saint Anthony](#), a significant pilgrimage site adorned with Renaissance art. In Padova, check into your hotel and prepare for an overnight stay, resting up for the next day's explorations in this historic city.

#### DAY 10: PADOVA - PISA – FLORANCE - AREZZO

After enjoying a breakfast at the hotel, set off on journey to Pisa. Along the way, we couldn't resist pausing for a photo at the iconic [Leaning Tower](#), capturing memories against its timeless silhouette. Continuing on, our next stop was the captivating city of [Florence through a Guided tour](#), where we immersed ourselves in its rich history and vibrant culture. From the awe-inspiring Duomo to the masterpieces housed in the Uffizi Gallery, each moment unveiled the city's artistic splendor. By evening, headed to Arezzo, where cozy accommodations awaited.

#### DAY 11: AREZZO – ROME – VATICAN - ROME

After breakfast, checkout and embark on a [Full-day Guided tour of Rome](#), immersing yourself in the Eternal City's rich history and vibrant culture. Start your journey at the [Colosseum](#), where you'll marvel at the grandeur of this ancient amphitheater, delving into tales of gladiatorial combat and Roman entertainment. Wander through the adjacent [Roman Forum](#), exploring the ruins of temples, arches, and marketplaces that once formed the heart of Rome's political and social life. Next, visit the [Pantheon](#), a marvel of engineering with its

imposing dome and oculus, serving as both a temple to all gods and a tomb for Italy's greats. Continue to the **Trevi Fountain**, a Baroque masterpiece where tradition holds that a coin tossed over your shoulder ensures a return to Rome. In the afternoon, head to **Piazza Navona**, a lively square adorned with Bernini's Fountain of the Four Rivers, and stroll through its bustling markets and artistic corners. Conclude your tour at **St. Peter's Basilica** in Vatican City, where the splendor of Michelangelo's Pietà and the grandeur of the basilica's architecture leave you in awe. Later, checked into the hotel for a comfortable overnight stay in the heart of the Eternal City.

#### **DAY 12: DEPARTS ROME**

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Checkout and proceed to Rome airport.
