DAY 01: ARRIVE PARIS

Arrival at Paris. Paris, a wonderful city brimming with character, is on every travel lover's bucket list. Known as the "City of Light" or the "City of Love," the streets of Paris overflow with culture, art, beauty, and history. At airport, meet and greet by our representative. Transfer to hotel for check -in. Evening experience Seine River Cruise through the heart of Paris, covering major attractions of Paris. Seeing the romantic city of Paris by boat is on the must-do list of most visitors to Paris. These short river cruises allow you to take in many of the highlights of the city. Dinner at Indian restaurant. After dinner proceed to Paris hotel for check in. Overnight stay.

DAY 02: FULL DAY PARIS SIGHTSEEING

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Proceed for a full day guided sightseeing tour of Paris covering Arc de Triomphe, Champs-Élysées, Les Invalides, Pantheon, Place de la Concorde, Palais Garnier. After lunch continue the guided sightseeing of Paris. Visit Louvre Museum. The Louvre is the world's largest museum and houses one of the most impressive art collections in history. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay at Paris hotel

DAY 03: PARIS – BRUSSELS - EINDHOVEN (04 HRS Approx.)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Departs Paris to Brussels. Lunch at local restaurant. After lunch proceed for a guided city tour of the elegant Brussels, the capital of Belgium and the headquarters of European Union. The sightseeing covers the magnificent grand place with its beautiful gilded buildings. We take you to see the adorable MannekenPis Statue, a charming statue of a little boy, today the symbol of Brussels. Here you can taste the famous Belgian chocolates and if you wish you may purchase. We end the tour with a visit to the famous Atomium, unavoidable icon of Brussels. This unique piece of architecture, created on the occasion of the World Fair of Brussels in 1958, became the most popular monument of the capital of Europe. After dinner transfer to Eindhoven Check-in to hotel for overnight stay

DAY 04: EINDHOVEN - AMSTERDAM - EINDHOVEN (02.5 HS Approx.)

After breakfast, checkout and proceed to Amsterdam, capital city of Netherlands which has gained popularity for its art, rich heritage, amazing canal system and its array of narrow houses, among other things. Enjoy orientation tour of Amsterdam. Visit the windmill village of Zaanse Schans, an open-air museum housing working windmills, wooden houses, barns, and shops dating back to the 18th and 19th centuries. Enjoy Amsterdam Canal Cruise. Discover the unique atmosphere of Amsterdam on this 75-minute canal cruise. See the UNESCO world heritage canals, the city's iconic bridges, and waterfront houses. Visit Keukenhof, also known as the Garden of Europe, is one of the world's largest flower gardens, situated in the municipality of Lisse, in the Netherlands. After dinner, check- in to the hotel. Overnight stay in Eindhoven.

DAY 05: EINDHOVEN - FRANKFURT

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Proceed for walking guided sightseeing tour of Cologne, one of the busiest cities in the world and the fourth-largest in Germany. Explore the old town of Cologne and walk in the footsteps of more than 2000 years moving local history. Experience Dom, Heinzelmännchenbrunnen, City

Hall, and Fish Market are just some of the stations, which are presented here by our experienced guide. After lunch, transfer to Frankfurt. Proceed for a **Guided sightseeing tour of Frankfurt** the financial hub of Germany and is on the bank of river Main. The city was almost fully destroyed during 2nd world war and now rebuilt. Dinner at Indian restaurant. After dinner drop at hotel for check in. Overnight stay.

DAY 06: FRANKFURT - ZURICH

After breakfast checkout and proceed to Stuttgart. Visit Mercedes Museum. The Museum celebrates the automobile invented by Carl Benz in 1886: it relates its history and tells its stories, bringing both alive by placing them in the context of technology, day-to-day life, social history and popular culture. Later continue to Zurich hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 07: ZURICH

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Begin the morning by visiting the highest mountain in central Switzerland, Mt. Titlis, which is 10,000 ft above sea level. The ascent to Mt. Titlis starts by taking three cable cars; enjoy breath-taking panoramic views of surrounding snow-capped mountains, lakes and picturesque meadows. At Mt. Titlis have free time to play with the snow. Lunch at Indian restaurant. After descending from Mt.Titlis transfer to Lucerne. Two hours walking/shopping tour of Lucerne. Lucerne is the most visited tourist destination in Switzerland and is situated on Lake Lucerne. You will visit the Chapel Bridge, the lion monument, The Rues river dam, the Jesuit church etc. Return back to Zurich. Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight stay.

DAY 08: ZURICH - SEEFELD

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Checkout and proceed for an orientation tour of Zurich. Experience the unique city landmarks such as the picturesque Old Town and the gorgeous Swiss National Museum. Discover Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, place where Albert Einstein studied. Enjoy a fantastic view of the valley from the Zurichberg. Later proceed to Vaduz, the capital of Liechtenstein. Experience Vaduz with the City Train. It takes the visitor to the historical part of old Vaduz, past the Vaduz vineyards, to stop below the famous Red House which is an ideal spot to take a picture of the panoramic view of Vaduz Castle, and continues through the magnificent, green countryside around Vaduz. The way back to the centre takes you past the "Rheinpark stadium", Liechtenstein's main sports stadium. Transfer to hotel checkin. Overnight stay.

DAY 09: SEEFELD - INNSBRUCK - MUNICH

After breakfast, timely checkout and head to Innsbruck Orientation City Tour. The tour offers a guided exploration of the historic Old Town, showcasing iconic landmarks like the Golden Roof and Hofburg Imperial Palace, providing a comprehensive introduction to the cultural and architectural heritage of this Austrian gem. Later Explore crystal in all its facets at the Swarovski Crystal Worlds Museum in Wattens. Enter a fantasy world that has fascinated millions of visitors, and discover the magic of the crystal at exhibits and attractions such as the gardens of The Giant, and the "Crystal Cloud" of 800,000 hand-mounted crystals. Transfer to Seefeld for overnight stay.

DAY 10: DEPARTS MUNICH

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Timely checkout and proceed for **Guided city tour of Munich**. The city is known for its beautiful architecture, with many historic buildings and landmarks that showcase a range of styles, from Gothic and Renaissance to Baroque and Neoclassical. Some of the most popular attractions in the city include the Marienplatz, a central square surrounded by beautiful buildings such as the Old Town Hall and the New Town Hall and the Residenz, a stunning palace that was the former home of the Bavarian monarchs. Evening proceed to Munich airport to catch your flight to home country
